

Conditions of accreditation

- I. The Responsible Person must submit to the Transport Commission a National Police Certificate issued by Tasmania Police or an equivalent interstate police authority, for the purposes of a schedule I record (extracted no more than 90 days prior to submission) for the Responsible Person no later than:
 - three years from the date of approval of the Accreditation; then
 - every three years thereafter.
- 2. The Responsible Person must submit to the Transport Commission a report which includes the registration number of every vehicle currently used under the authority of the accreditation within 7 days of the start of every calendar month.

- 3. The Responsible Person must develop and maintain a risk management system for the service to identify:
 - (a) any reasonably foreseeable hazards that could give rise to risks to the health, safety or security of drivers, passengers or other persons in connection with the passenger transport service for which the person is accredited; and
 - (b) any measures taken to eliminate or minimise those risks; and
 - (c) any improvements subsequently made to the measures specified in paragraph (b) following an incident affecting the health, safety or security of a driver, passenger or other person in connection with the passenger transport service for which the person is accredited.
- 4. If the Operator nominates a new Responsible Person for the Accreditation, the Operator must submit a current National Police Certificate issued by Tasmania Police or an equivalent interstate police authority, for the purposes of a schedule I record for the nominated person with the nomination form.

Responsible person

The Passenger Transport Services Act 2011 provides that if the holder of accreditation is a body politic, a partnership or an incorporated or unincorporated body it must have a natural person to be the responsible person for the accreditation.

If a person ceases to be the responsible person, the Operator must notify the Transport Commission within 14 days and nominate a new responsible person.

The person nominated is to be -

in the case of a body politic	a member or senior employee of the body politic
in the case of a partnership	one of the partners
in the case of an incorporated body	one of its officers or employees
in the case of an unincorporated body	one of its members
